Please note, funding is not guaranteed. All funding is determined by the individual program upon or after offer of academic admission. Not all programs have all funding options. Applicants are not considered for funding until a complete application has been submitted and reviewed by the program. Conditionally admitted students cannot use financial aid awards for intensive English in ECU Language Academy (ECULA).

Basic types of funding explained:

- **GRANTS:** Generally given to students with the greatest financial need
- **GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIP:** A paid student-work position
- SCHOLARSHIPS: Merit-based awards that recognize special achievement, talents or skills
- **OUT-OF-STATE TUITION REMISSION:** You are allowed to pay North Carolina resident tuition rates instead of the out-of-state tuition rate
