### ABOUT ECU

ECU is a comprehensive university with a nationally ranked medical school, a dental school, doctoral programs in biomedical sciences, and a college of engineering and technology.

Popular programs include master's degrees in biomedical engineering, business administration (MBA), public health (MPH), communication, psychology, and numerous MAEd programs in a variety of teaching disciplines. Popular certificate programs include health communication, health informatics, marketing and many others.

ECU offers campus-based, online and hybrid options in many programs.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted to a master's or doctoral program, you must have the equivalent of a U.S. bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited university.

- **TOEFL requirement:**  
IBT – total score: 78, section scores: 18
- **IELTS requirement:** 6.5
- **Duolingo test:** Required score is 115.

The Graduate School does not require standardized test scores. However, some programs may require scores for admission review.

Programs may offer waivers for standardized test scores. Contact programs for details.

Conditional admission may be offered to international applicants without submission of TOEFL or IELTS or GRE scores. Conditional admission requires successful completion of the language academy at East Carolina University and submission of GRE scores prior to full admission in an academic program. 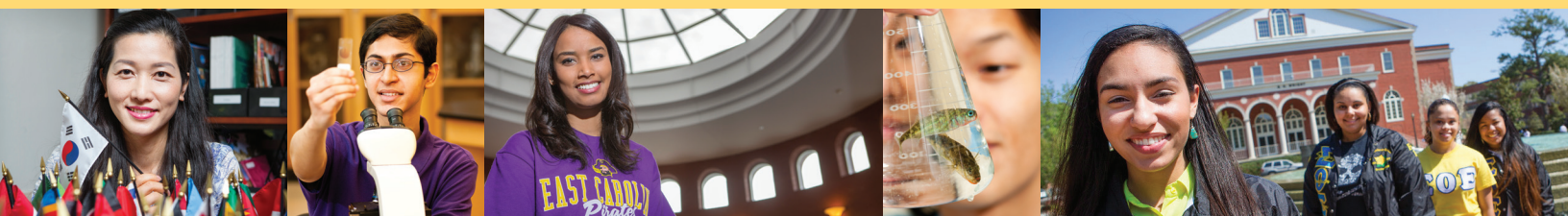


## STEP 1

### Program Deadlines

- Priority Deadlines – primary date that programs use to begin reviewing applications and used by some programs where funding is often associated with an offer of admission. Applicants who submit and complete their application by a priority deadline are considered for financial awards prior to those who submit after the priority deadline.
- Graduate School – this is the standard deadline used to accept applications. NOTE: Some programs may adhere to their Priority Deadline only. Please contact your program of interest to confirm the application deadline they prefer.
- International Students – there is no set deadline but students should allow an additional one (1) to two (2) months prior to the listed deadlines for processing of VISA or other required paperwork.

### Application Availability

Applications for future terms are generally made available to the public 10-11 months prior to the program's specific deadline.


